Scholarship & Financial Aid

1. Handong Cornerstone Scholarship

 Both the applicant and his/her parents must be native citizens of a designated developing countries and hold nationalities of developing countries (compiled by Korea International Cooperation Agency). The applicant must have graduated or will graduate from a nationally accredited institution with a high school diploma or equivalent of such.

2. Entrance Scholarship for International Students

- · Korean: Students with a valid Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) Score
- English: Students with a valid, Official English Language Test Score
 - * Test scores must be valid at the time of Application Deadline

3. Outstanding International Students

 Select international students from overseas who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and have characteristics sought by the university

4. Asian Christian Leaders Scholarship

 Scholarship to train Christian Leaders from Hong Kong, Taiwan, Japan, China, and Singapore (Students that hold nationalities and graduate from high school in these countries only)

5. Scholarship for Academic Performance (for enrolled students)

- Students who possess a Korean Test score (at the time of end of each semester)
- Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) above Level 4
- Students who possess an English Test Score (at the time of end of each semester)
 - TOEFL iBT 85 and above / IELTS Level 6.0 and above / TEPS 600 and above


