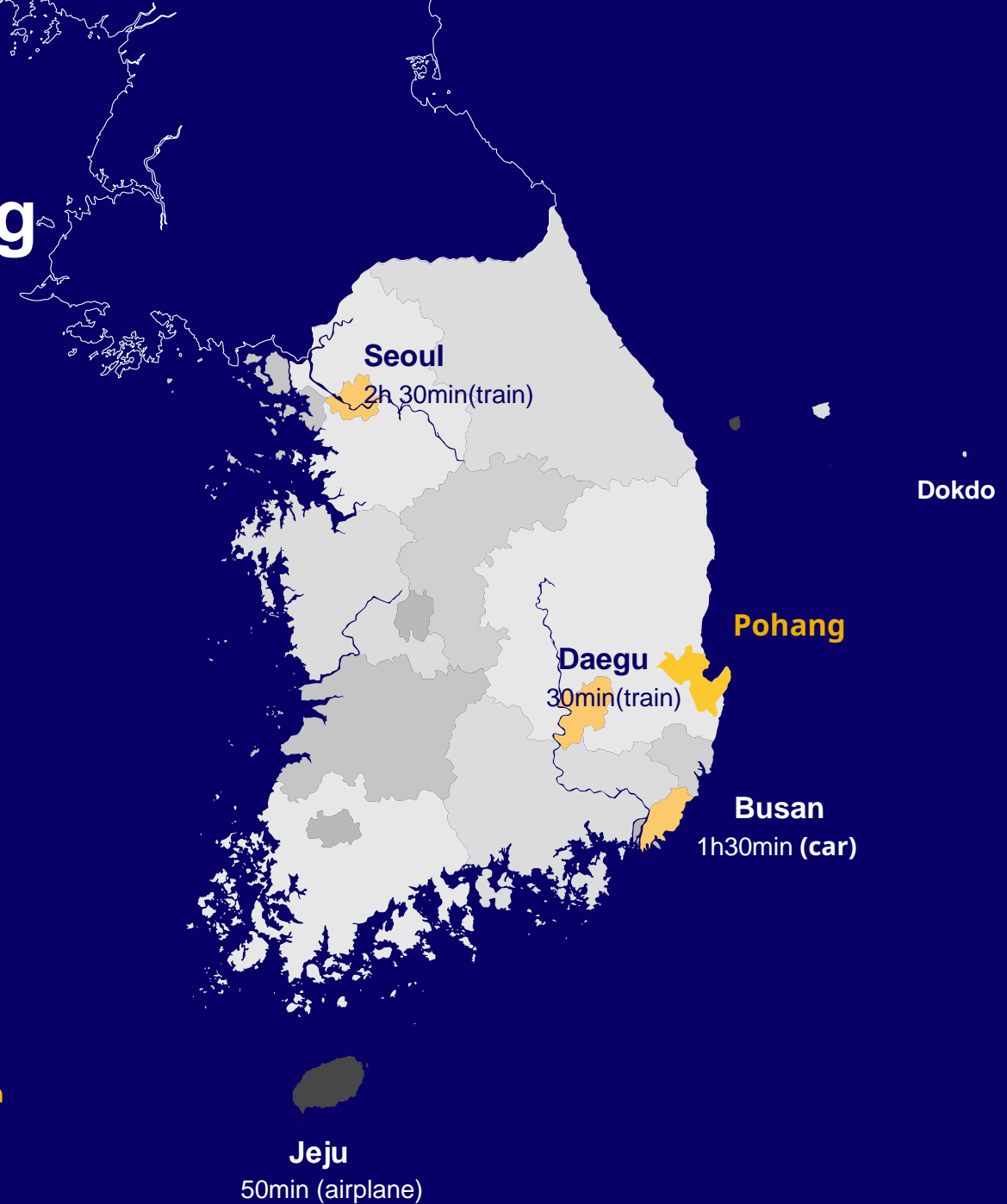

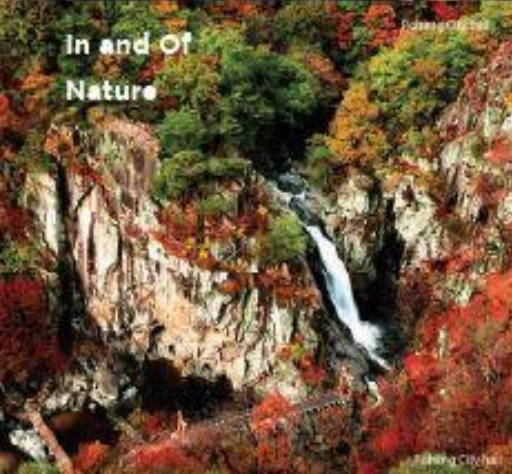




POHANG

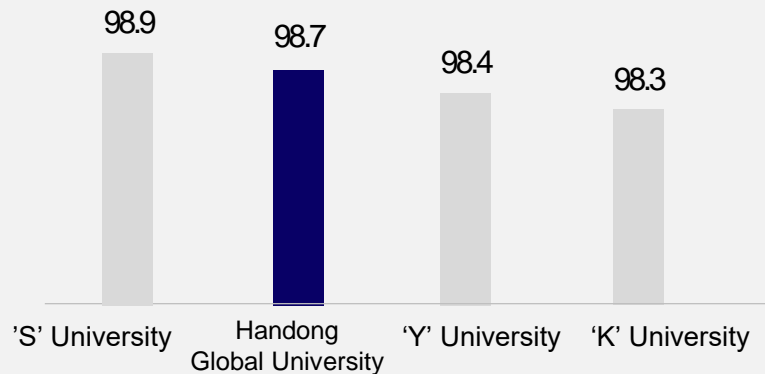

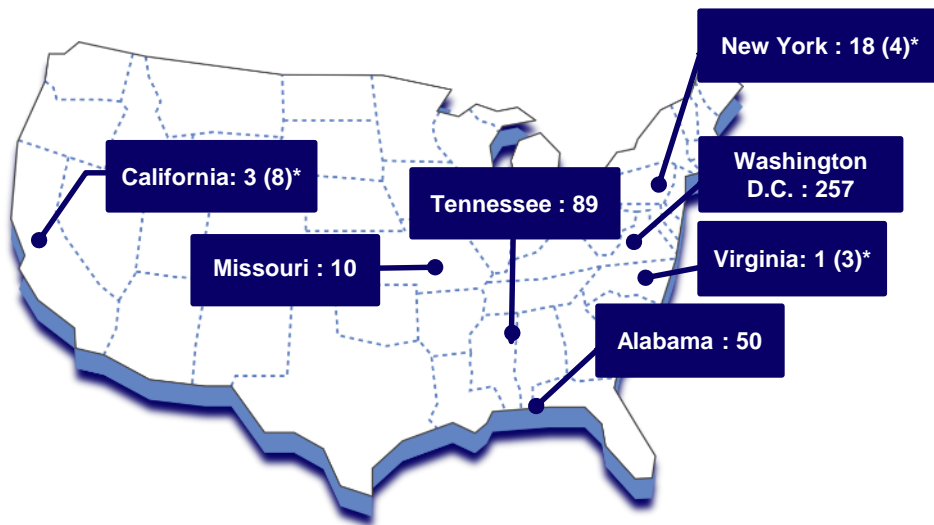
